- Staffing for 2021-22

- Covid Update
 - Rapid Testing at Lakie
 - The school was notified April 28th that Lakie was selected as a rapid testing school.
 - The school is expecting rapid testing to take place within the next week or so.
- Final Exams we will have finals this year. Finals will not necessarily be comprehensive and cumulative from the beginning of the school year, but there will likely be some degree of culminative. Math will be the exception, being cumulative to the beginning of the school year.

- o 10-15% weighting across the board. Some summative assessments will be project based.
- Learning structures in LSD for September 2021
 - Forecast is likely that AB Government will mandate schools provide the option for students to choose online learning vs in-person learning, as we did this year, however, there would be no pivot points as the division implemented this year. Aslearning Program, as that program is separate and apart from Covid related issues.
 - LSD survey going out to determine which families would like online learning to start off the year
 - o LSD *may* allow the opportunity for students to join a 2nd cohort to start off the year. This would possibly be a homeroom and extra-circular cohort, which would allow for a soft transition back into implementing extra-curriculars.
