2. Administrator's Report – Doug James

- a) Powerschool will be used for electronic report cards. Parents need to go online to find report cards for their students. Marks are cumulative. All middle schools in Leth 51 report the same way.
- b) Remembrance Day ceremonies went well.
- c) Aladdin performances are almost sold out (both evening and afternoon). There will be 10 performances and over 3600 people will watch the performance from December 12-16.
- d) Christmas Concert for music students is December 19
- e) Next Council meeting is scheduled for January 17. Cheryl Gilmore will be attending to get parent input on a new principal as Doug is set to retire at the end of this school year. Lakie has a unique culture. Staff have discussed Lakie's culture and what Lakie values are.

4. Presentation-Dan Westwood

- Dan Westwood presented about the proposed Multi-Use Outdoor Sport Facility which would tentatively open September 2018. Relocatables will be moved when the new west side middle school opens (resulting in Lakie population decreasing) which will free up an area of land where this facility can be built.
- Currently the Lakie gym is not big enough, so a multi-sport facility to use during gym time, for option classes, as well as for public use after school hours would be welcome.
- facility could possibly support basketball, tennis, outdoor hockey, volleyball
- proposed to be 25m x 30m, or 20m x 36m
- cost estimate is \$260,000-\$325,000
