1. Administrator's Report – Doug James

2. District School Council Report

3. Old Business

 Update from By Law Review Sub-Committee. We reviewed the major changes from Bylaws to Operating Procedures and discussed the voting procedure. The Council decided that Admin representatives on School Council should be non-voting members.

4. New Business

- Reviewed the format of this year's School Council meetings. People really liked the featured discussion topic as a way to increase interest among parents. Also, having teachers present to explain and give their perspectives on issues was valuable. We should encourage and promote this next year. We may want to consider if we should use a round table format and whether there can be a student activity offered at the same time as School Council ie: open games night in the gym or open computer labs.
- Discussion topics for next year:
 - 1. What are the outcomes of the skills development exercise? What are the skills that a grade 6/7/8 student should have? What are the outcomes of the Levelled Reading Program? Are targets being met? How will this program be expanded next year?

 - 3. We should host another Digital Citizenship discussion topic in October for new grade 6 parents so they understand the perspective of the school and the direction we are headed.
