- We have numeracy and literacy committees that will go over PAT results to create action plans
- We numeracy and literacy pull out supports for students identified as having gaps in learning
- Teachers have assessed gaps in learning and are strategizing to better meet the needs of students
- Utilization of thinking routines in more of our classrooms to promote deeper level thinking and to provide access points for all students
- We've reviewed final exams in grades 7 & 8 to address areas of concern from grade 6 PAT results
- When we look at data from students that actually wrote PAT's, our data was much better and much closer to Provincial averages

- At Lakie, we live by the FISH philosophy. Teachers incorporate lessons pertaining to this into advisor time, we talk about it regularly as a school and we advertise it heavily within our building. Ultimately, the FISH philosophy encourages students to be good citizens, make good choices and be there for others in need.
- We have a leadership group, led by our teacher counsellor, that develops and implements a variety of initiatives aimed at making our school a better place.
- With COVID restrictions now lifted, we have been able to get back to offering events that build community and citizenship in our building. These include school dances, FISH Friday activities, concerts, and a variety of clubs and extracurriculars.
- The focal point of our building is our foyer. It's the central hub of Lakie that is used at all times of the day for a variety of purposes. We have slowly reintroduced it as a place for students to hang out before and after school, during breaktimes, as a place for students to eat their lunches and as a place to gather as a community to celebrate events. In doing so, this increases citizenship in our building.
- Variety of clubs and groups offered at Lakie for students to find their niche and connection to school. Some examples are: chess and board games (D&D), Indigenous Leadership Group, long-boarding, Positive Spaces, Travel Club, Band, etc.

- With COVID restrictions now lifted, we have been able to welcome the community back into our building. Some families have commented that this year has been the first time they've been able to enter our building in the three years their child has been a student at Lakie.
- Already this fall, we've hosted an in-person Meet the Teacher night, parent-teacher interviews, sporting events, Indigenous bingo and School Council meetings. In the near future, we will once again host a Gatorstock guitar show and a winter band concert. Each of these events brings families into our building and engages them in their child's experience at Lakie. Lakie is well known for hosting such events and we're happy to once again be able to do so.
- Our administrative team is receptive to feedback about the options and opportunities we offer. While we can't offer everything that is suggested, our staff is very invested in providing opportunities for our student body.
- Our learning support team works hard to meet the specific needs of our students. They host many L-Team meetings with families and educational staff to ensure we're working together to meet the needs of their child.
