iii. Fruit Fundraiser

- We decided in November that we would do a citrus fruit fundraiser. Tisha advises there are 2 different oranges typically brough in. We will be getting the smaller and sweeter oranges for our fundraiser. They are California oranges. Full boxes have 88 oranges at \$60/box, with \$8.00 being our profit. If we sell half boxes for \$35, we will profit \$9.00 (\$18.00/full box). NOTE: It's been decided to sell half boxes for \$36/box to account for School Cash Online Transaction Fee of 4%.
- We will try to start taking orders next Monday, January 23, 2023, as orders will need to close on February 4. Vanessa and Tisha will work this out with Cathy in the office. Mike will prepare the flyer regarding the fundraiser and get it to Cathy by tomorrow morning (Friday).

- We can also sell grapefruit if we are interested, however, have decided to keep the fundraiser simply given the limited amount of time. We can consider adding grapefruit to next years fundraiser.
- Fruit should be arriving February 10 or 11. Tisha will store fruit until Monday, February 13, at which time she'll deliver it to the school for pickup.
- Volunteers will be needed to sort fruit at the school on Monday. Exact details to follow.
- What are we fundraising for: "Oranges for options" will be the catch phrase.
