### **Lakie Device Protocol**

Prior to the February break we ran a pilot project where we eliminated all personal electronic devices from all grade 6 classrooms. This arose from staff concerns that more and more students were distracted by devices and as a result were less engaged in their learning. Naturally, less grade 6's have them, use them, and are as reliant on them as our 7's & 8's. Attachment to devices only seems to increase as our youth get older. As a result, we have revamped our school device policy stating that personal digital devices are no longer to be in the classroom at any point. We recommend they stay at home altogether, but if brought to school, the only times they are permitted to be accessed is before school, lunchtime, and/or after school. For this policy to be effective, we truly need the cooperation and support from our families. Simply put, it is in the best interest of your child's learning. 
