## **Bus Information**

Southland Transportation Ltd is the provider for bussing in our Division. For more information, as well as access to the MyBusStop app, visit the Southland website at <a href="https://www.lethsd.ab.ca/transportation/mybusstop-app">https://www.lethsd.ab.ca/transportation/mybusstop-app</a>. To access your school code, visit the page, and enter the password: **southlandcodes**. A reminder that to qualify for bussing, a student's primary address must qualify by being 2.4 km or more away from the school. This is according to the software they use, as opposed to the likes of Google Maps. If you feel your address qualifies your child for bussing, but they currently don't, please contact Christine in our office. New bus boundaries, as communicated by the government this past spring, will not come into effect until the 2024-25 school year.

## Attendance - Absences

Daily attendance can be monitored via PowerSchool, as mentioned above. If your child is going to be away or needs to leave early, please inform the office in advance. This can be done by phone, or better yet, the Safe Arrival app. You can download this in the app store on your phone (SchoolMessenger app) or submit it on the Safe Arrival website (https://go.schoolmessenger.com).

# <u>Lakie Canteen - Need Parent Volunteers!</u>

For the 2023-24 school year, G.S Lakie is <u>not</u> offering daily canteen services. Instead, there will be a bi-weekly rotation of hot lunches that students can order, two days per week. Orders will need to be made on <u>School Cash Online</u> the week before, with the cutoff for orders being Wednesday evening of each week. Currently, we are working with Quesada, Boston Pizza, Booster Juice, and Subway as our hot lunch vendors.

Weekly menus will be posted on the school website and in our weekly Gator Gab newsletter. Online ordering will be available Monday, Sept. 11, with the first hot lunch being delivered on Tuesday, September 19. Lakie also provides a well-stocked vending machine on site with an assortment of snacks and drinks.

As was the case last year, we will need parent help to distribute food each day in our canteen (Monday-Thursday). Ideally, our hope is to obtain 8-10 volunteers so each person would only need to commit a couple hours every other week. The commitment would simply require volunteers to take pre-packaged orders and place them in bins for a student from each cohort to pick up just prior to their eating time. The time commitment would be:

Tuesday, September 12<sup>th</sup>. Smile ③. The picture schedule will work around PE classes to ensure students get to wear clothing of their choice!


## **School Zones**
