### **Attendance Matters!**

#### Did you know?

- Students should miss no more than 9 days of school each year to stay engaged, successful and on track to graduation.
- Frequent absences can be a sign that a student is losing interest in school, struggling with schoolwork, dealing with a bully or facing some other difficulty.
- By 6<sup>th</sup> grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may not graduate high school
- By 9<sup>th</sup> grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8<sup>th</sup> grade test scores.
- Missing 10%, or 2 days per month, over the course of the school year, can affect a student's academic success.
