#### Alberta Education Assurance (AEA)

**ATTENTION grade 7 parents**! Alberta Education administers an annual assurance survey for students and parents in grades 4, 7 & 10. The survey provides parents the opportunity to give feedback in all areas of your child's education at GS Lakie. For data to be as valid as possible, we ask all grade 7 families to complete the survey prior to the **March 21<sup>st</sup> deadline**. Data from the survey is somewhat of a "report card" for our school and is essential for future planning. Each grade 7 student's household will receive one random access code (RAC) to complete the survey. An information package, along with your RAC, will be sent home. The RAC is only for the parent survey, grade 7 students will complete theirs at school.

#### Middle School Registration for 2025/26

Middle school and high school registration will open Monday, March 10<sup>th</sup>. Information from Lakie for grade 5 students moving into grade 6 will be sent directly to each feeder school, with key dates for orientations and parent nights outlined. Registration is the first step of preparing for next year followed by option selection which will open Friday, May 9<sup>th</sup>. 2025/26 student registration will occur through the <u>School Engage</u> platform, which can be accessed through the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u>. #### Lost Locks

Communication will go out to all families on Monday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> regarding an ongoing issue with students not latching their locks and locks going missing as a result. Due to the volume of locks being replaced, we will start enforcing an existing rule where students will be charged for replacement costs (\$12). Please have a conversation with your child about always latching their locks. This not only protects their belongings but also ensures their lock doesn't go missing.


