Alberta Education Assurance (AEA)

ATTENTION grade 7 parents! Alberta Education administers an annual assurance survey for students and parents in grades 4, 7 & 10. The survey provides parents the opportunity to give feedback in all areas of your child's education at GS Lakie. For data to be as valid as possible, we ask all grade 7 families to complete the survey prior to the **deadline**. **UPDATE – Alberta Education has extended the deadline to March 28th.**

Data from the survey is somewhat of a “report card” for our school and is essential for future planning. Each grade 7 student's household will receive one random access code (RAC) to complete the survey. An information package, along with your RAC, will be sent home. The RAC is only for the parent survey, grade 7 students will complete theirs at school.

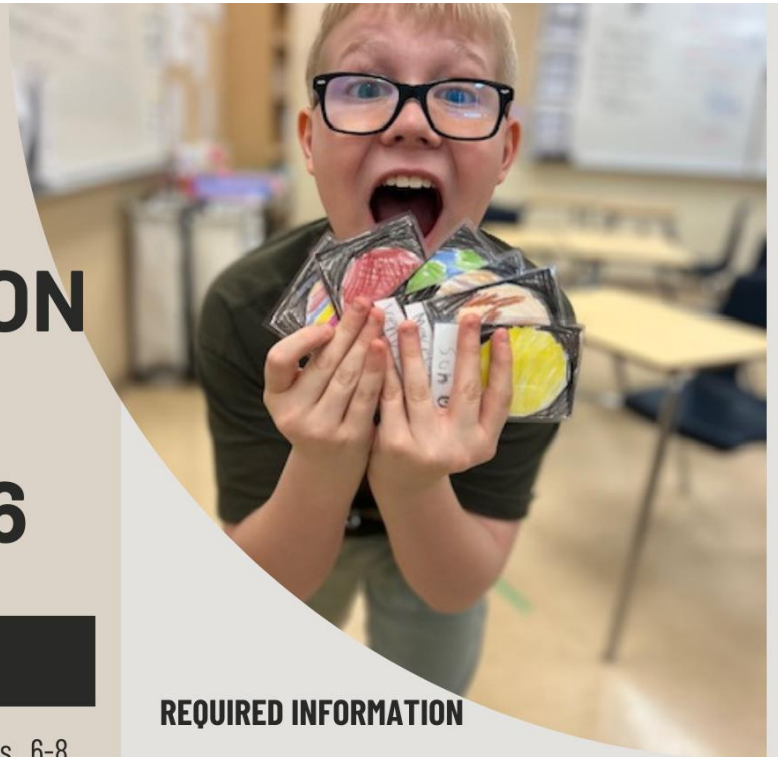
