Middle School Registration for 2025/26

Middle school and high school registration will open Monday, March 10th. Information from Lakie for grade 5 students moving into grade 6 will be sent directly to each feeder school, with key dates for orientations and parent nights outlined. Registration is the first step of preparing for next year followed by option selection which will open Friday, May 9th. 2025/26 student registration will occur through the <u>School Engage</u> platform, which can be accessed through the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u>.
